

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPERTY OWNERS' PETITION FOR
VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION INTO THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA**

Interested persons are hereby notified that the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the "Council") will hold a public hearing during the special meeting of the Council scheduled for 7:00 p.m., on September 16, 2020, at the Whiteland Town Hall, 549 Main Street, Whiteland, Indiana 46184, upon proposed Ordinance No. 2020-12, An Ordinance Annexing approximately 184 acres of Property owned by Zella I. Rose, Glenn A. and Rebecca S. Havemen, 8th Generation LLC, and Michael W. and Lynne W. O'Brien as Voluntarily Petitioned by the property owners. This Ordinance would annex into the Town of Whiteland, through a voluntary annexation, an unincorporated area currently owned by Zella I. Rose, Glenn A. and Rebecca S. Havemen, 8th Generation LLC, and Michael W. and Lynne W. O'Brien, generally located West of I-65 and N. 300 E./Warrior Trail and on the South side of 600 N./Tracy Road, consisting of approximately 184 acres identified as Parcel Nos. 41-05-23-041-023.002-033, 41-05-23-014-005.000-033, 41-05-23-042-022.001-033, 41-05-23-031-022.000-033, 41-05-23-031-021.000-033, 41-05-23-021-001.000-033 41-05-23-013-006.001-033, and 41-05-23-024-001.000-033 (the "Annexation Territory"). The Council reserves the right, prior to taking final action, (or if the Ordinance is ultimately adopted, prior to its effective date) to amend the Ordinance. The proposed Ordinance and a legal description and map of the Annexation Territory are available for inspection by the public at the Whiteland Town Hall. At the public hearing, all interested parties shall have an opportunity to testify and be heard concerning the proposed annexation, and the hearing may be continued to a later date or dates.
