

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPERTY OWNERS' PETITION FOR
VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION INTO THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA**

Interested persons are hereby notified that the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the "Council") will hold a public hearing during the regular meeting of the Council scheduled for 7:00 p.m., on September 8, 2020, at the Whiteland Town Hall, 549 Main Street, Whiteland, Indiana 46184, upon proposed Ordinance No. 2020-10, An Ordinance Annexing 72.11 acres of property owned by Howard Management Company, LLC, Shelby D. Howard, III, and Shelby & Tonya Howard. This Ordinance would annex into the Town of Whiteland, through a voluntary annexation, an unincorporated area generally located on the east side of Emerson Avenue, south of Pushville Road, and north of Tracy Road, consisting of approximately 72.11 acres identified as Parcel Nos. 41-05-15-031-007.000-033; 41-05-15-032-007.003-033; 41-05-15-032-008.000-033; and 41-05-15-031-008.001-033 (the "Annexation Territory"). The Council reserves the right, prior to taking final action, (or if the Ordinance is ultimately adopted, prior to its effective date) to amend the Ordinance. The proposed Ordinance and a legal description and map of the Annexation Territory are available for inspection by the public at the Whiteland Town Hall. At the public hearing, all interested parties shall have an opportunity to testify and be heard concerning the proposed annexation, and the hearing may be continued to a later date or dates.
