

ORDINANCE 2018-03

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS

WHEREAS, the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana, finds it necessary to use electronic funds transfer transactions including online banking transfers for payments, deposits, and receipts of funds pursuant to Indiana Code 5-13-5-5;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana now determines it to be appropriate to authorize electronic funds transfers transactions, including online transfer transactions, pursuant to Indiana Code 5-13-5-5; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to incorporate such authorization into the Whiteland Municipal Code as Sections 33.12 and 33.13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana, that:

Section 1. Electronic Funds Transfers. The Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), is hereby amended to add Sections 33.12 and 33.13, to read as follows:

ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS

§ 33.12 Authorization

The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to conduct transactions of the town with a financial institution or a public pension or retirement fund administered by the Indiana public retirement system, by electronic funds transfer, including without limitation, Automatic Clearing House, Electronic Funds Transfer, and online banking transfers, for all payments, deposits, and receipts of funds considered appropriate by the Clerk-Treasurer, pursuant to Indiana Code 5-13-5-5.

§ 33.13 Documentation for Audits

The Clerk-Treasurer is required to maintain adequate documentation of all electronic funds transfer transactions for future audits, as provided by law.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final adoption.
