

WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-12

A PETITION TO APPEAL FOR AN INCREASE ABOVE THE MAXIMUM LEVY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Government Modernization Act found at Ind. Code 36-1.5 *et. seq.*, the residents of the Town of Whiteland (the "Town") and the Whiteland Fire Protection District (the "District") have voted to consolidate the District into the Town to more effectively and efficiently provide fire protection services to the Town and the District;

WHEREAS, the Department of Local Government Finance has determined that in order for the amount of the tax levy previously taxed and collected by the District to be taxed and collected by the Town following the consolidation, the Town must apply for an excess property tax levy; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Johnson County, State of Indiana, has determined to appeal to the Department of Local Government Finance for an excess property tax levy (the "Excess Property Tax Levy"):

Annexation/Consolidation/Reorganization/Extension of Services \$191,528
(IC 6-1.1-18.5-13(a)(1))

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. The fiscal body of the Town of Whiteland, Johnson County, hereby resolves to proceed with a petition for an Excess Property Tax Levy to the Department of Local Government Finance to permanently increase the taxing unit's maximum levy, and we represent that the taxing unit cannot carry out its governmental functions under its current maximum levy for the ensuing calendar year, and future years, without the excess levy.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.




