RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03**

**ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION AND TRANSFER RESOLUTION FOR BUDGET
YEAR 2018**

(Community Crossing Matching Grant)

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland (“Town”) Town Council has received a \$559,310.78 Community Crossing Matching Grant from the Indiana Department of Transportation (“INDOT”) for certain infrastructure improvement projects;

WHEREAS, I.C. 8-23-30 authorizes matching grants to local units to be used for eligible projects undertaken by a local unit that repair or increase the capacity of local roads and bridges and that are part of the local unit’s transportation asset management plan (the “Restricted Infrastructure Uses”);

WHEREAS, the Town’s matching funds need to be transferred to the Town’s LOCAL ROAD AND BRIDGE MATCHING GRANT FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has published notice in accordance with Ind. Code §§ 5-3-1 and 6-1.1-18-5, and held a public hearing regarding the appropriation of Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. The \$559,310.78 in Community Crossing Matching Grant funds from INDOT are hereby authorized to be deposited into the Local Road and Bridge Matching Grant Fund and such funds are APPROPRIATED to be used for the construction/reconstruction of roads and streets of the Town of Whiteland consistent with the permitted Restricted Infrastructure Uses.
2. To satisfy the Town’s matching requirements, the amount of \$190,273.23 of previously appropriated funds in the Town’s LRS (\$140,000) Fund & MVH (\$51,000) Fund is hereby transferred to the Town’s LOCAL ROAD AND BRIDGE MATCHING GRANT FUND to be used for the construction/reconstruction of roads and streets of the Town of Whiteland consistent with the permitted Restricted Infrastructure Uses.
3. The appropriations in this Resolution are in addition to all other appropriations of the Council and the Town for 2018.
4. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to provide information and a copy of this appropriation Resolution to the State Department of Local Government Finance.
5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect as of the date of adoption of this Resolution.
