**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL'S
WILLINGNESS TO CONSIDER A MERGER OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND WITH
THE TOWN OF NEW WHITELAND**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland ("Whiteland") has become aware that there are residents of the towns of Whiteland and New Whiteland that have expressed an interest in seeing Whiteland and New Whiteland merge into a single municipality;

WHEREAS, the towns of Whiteland and New Whiteland share many common interests and provide many common services to their respective residents and property owners; and

WHEREAS, Indiana law allows two adjacent municipalities to merge upon the express approval of the residents of those towns through a vote on a public question presented at a public election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, THAT:


1. The Town Council of the Town of Whiteland is willing to consider and further investigate a possible merger with the Town of New Whiteland.
2. This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
