

Whiteland Stormwater Meeting
June 8, 2016

Julie Dwire called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Others present: Stephen Watson-Town Attorney, Rusty Snyder-MS4 Coordinator/Building Commissioner, Debra L. Hendrickson-Clerk/Treasurer

Darrell Cline made a motion to approve the minutes from May 11, 2016 meeting. Julie Dwire seconded the motion. Passed 2-0

Darrell Cline made a motion to approve the Voucher Packet 16-05. Julie Dwire seconded the motion. Passed 2-0. Hendrickson reported on the question from Julie Dwire pertaining to the last meeting about the transfers from the Storm account into the Gen. Bond Anti. Note, were reimbursements from the State for the Roundabout construction. The State chose the Storm Bank account to deposit the funds into so the town has to make a transfer to the correct account so it can be appropriated.

The Board stepped outside for a Permeability Asphalt Demonstration at 7:07. The Board returned at 7:15 after the demonstration. The demonstration was to determine water impacts different surface driveways in order for a possible rate reduction for business owners for storm fees. Dwire inquired how many people it would impact and confirmation that it won't impact the revenue immensely. Rusty recommended Norm Gabehart-Town Manager come to the next meeting with a proposal. Stephen Watson read the town code §51.48 D Stormwater user fee calculation formula. Julie Dwire agreed that Norm Gabehart attend the next meeting to see how to make the determination.

Rusty reported the Johnson Memorial Hospital Building project is moving forward. He also noted the Roundabout will be opening at 11:00 on June 11, 2016.
