RESOLUTION 2014-07 A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL, WHITELAND, INDIANA, TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF THE COALITION APPLICATION FOR EPA BROWNFIELDS ASSESSMENT GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland has determined that it should be proactive in the restoration of environmentally impaired sites to productive and beneficial use;

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides grants to communities for the assessment of environmentally contaminated properties;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a unified administrative/legislative effort would be advantageous to the Town of Whiteland when pursuing EPA brownfield assessment funding;

WHEREAS, the grant will be a cooperative effort between a "Coalition" of communities and include the Town of Whiteland, the City of Greenwood, and the City of Franklin, with the City of Greenwood serving as the grant recipient and administrator; and

WHEREAS, upon award of the grant, the Town of Whiteland understands that the Coalition members will finalize a binding Memorandum of Agreement to document the allocation of grant funds, administrative and programmatic tasks for the grant project, site selection process, and Coalition member responsibilities among others.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town of Whiteland, Indiana supports the application to the EPA for the EPA Brownfield Assessment Grant to fund environmental assessment activities at Brownfield sites in the Town of Whiteland.

Section 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Town Council.
