Call to order

- J. Saylor called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm

Roll Call – Brad Goedecker was absent

Adoption of the Order of Business

- Request of Change Order for Springhill Subdivision Construction
 - K. McGinnis stated the road construction for the Community Crossing Grant had started. (A video of the roads is being shown). When the milling was off some of the asphalt the roads were in awful condition from Springdale down to Pinedale and Colony. Margate and Briarhill wasn't quite as bad. When the subdivision was created there was no base like today's roads. Once it rained three inches of rain last weekend and it ran under the concrete and caused the issue. Wallace was able to excavate the wet spots and brought asphalt fillings to fill it in so they are drivable.
 - S. Watson stated the change order is similar to the main contract in pricing. K. McGinnis had attached the proposal.
 - L. Fleury inquired when the change order would start. Wallace representative stated on Tuesday.
 - D. Hawkins inquired what kind of material will be used for underlayment? - Geogrid would be used and it will disburse the weight better and stone will be laid on it.
 - D. Hawkins inquired why they are not using lime? - The road would have to be taken up completely.
 - D. Hawkins inquired how long would this fix last? - Approximately 10 – 15 years.
 - R. Hill inquired what caused the problem. K. McGinnis stated it is lack of water removal.
 - R. Hill inquired how do you know you are going deep enough. – From experience.
 - D. Hawkins inquired if they could alleviate the water drainage problem. - Where it is staked is where they will put the slope in.
