## WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY GRANT FUND

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland expects to receive money dispersed pursuant to the American Recovery Plan Act ("ARP");

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts ("ISBOA") has issued guidance to counties, cities, and towns prescribing the required accounting procedures for recipients of money from the ARP;

WHEREAS, a part of that guidance requires recipients to adopt an ordinance establishing a separate local grant fund called the ARP Coronavirus Local Grant Fund to receive the monetary disbursement;

WHEREAS, the guidance from the ISBOA also requires the ordinance to specify the uses for which the recipient anticipates using the funds; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to adopt an ordinance establishing the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Grant Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Grant Fund 176 ("Fund") is hereby established as a special non-reverting fund.
- Section 2. The Town shall only appropriate and use moneys received into the Fund to cover costs incurred by the Town by December 31, 2024, for the following purposes:
  - a. to respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
  - b. to respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers of the Town that are performing such essential work, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who perform essential work;
  - c. for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of the Town due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the Town prior to the emergency; or,
  - d. to make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

Section 3. The Town Council shall adopt a plan providing details for the use of the moneys in the Fund.

Section 4. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution are separable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution.
