ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION FOR BUDGET YEAR 2022 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland (the "Town") originally projected to receive approximately \$1,023,000 under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARP"), in two installments, with fifty (50%) of the funds having already been received by the Town in 2021, and fifty (50%) of the funds to be received in 2022, which funds have earned interest and will continue to earn interest until expended (collectively, the "ARP Funds");

WHEREAS, the Town has received an additional supplemental distribution of ARP Funds in the amount of \$1,936.49;

WHEREAS, the Town Council plans to use the additional ARP Funds for technology purchases for the Whiteland Clerk-Treasurer's Office;

WHEREAS, the Town has published notice in accordance with Ind. Code §§ 5-3-1 and 6-1.1-18-5, and held a public hearing regarding the appropriation within this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. An appropriation of \$1,936.49 from the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Grant Fund 176 (the ARP Funds) is hereby made as follows:

<u>Clerk-Treasurer</u>. \$1,936.49 of the ARP Funds is allocated for use by the Whitland Clerk-Treasurer's Office for the purchase of new technology, including but not limited to, a laptop computer and typewriter.

- 2. The appropriations in this Resolution are in addition to all other appropriations of the Town Council and the Town for 2022.
- 3. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to provide information and a copy of this appropriation Resolution to the State Department of Local Government Finance.
- 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect as of the date of adoption of this Resolution.
