NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF HEARING ON PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF CUMULATIVE BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT FUND

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the Town of Whiteland, Johnson County, Indiana and the fire protection service area of the Town of Whiteland Fire Department (formerly the Whiteland Fire Protection District service territory), that the Whiteland Town Council will hold a public hearing and consider at a meeting of the Town Council to be held at the Whiteland Town Hall, 549 Main Street, Whiteland, IN 46184, at 7:00 o'clock p.m., on May 10, 2022, the establishment of a Cumulative Building and Equipment Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-8-14 for the following purposes: For all uses as set out in IC 36-8-14 (in summary, for purchases and expenditures supporting firefighting and emergency medical services).

The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within the taxing district (formerly the Whiteland Fire Protection District service territory) and will not exceed \$0.033 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in the year 2023. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposal for establishment of the Cumulative Building and Equipment Fund is subject to certification by the Department of Local Government Finance.

Within 30 days after the date of the adoption of the cumulative fund by the Whiteland Town Council, the Town of Whiteland will publish a Notice of Adoption.

Upon publication of the Notice of Adoption, 25 or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon 30 days after the publication of the Notice of Adoption setting forth their objections to the proposed fund.
