### WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2023-05

# A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code § 6-3.6-6-9.5, in order for the Town of Whiteland ("Town") to receive its share of the Johnson County Economic Development Income Tax, the Whiteland Town Council ("Council") must adopt a capital improvement plan specifying the uses of additional revenue to be allocated for economic development purposes;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to use revenues generated from the County Economic Development Income Tax ("CEDIT") for the economic development purposes specified under Indiana Code § 6-3.6-10-2, which includes any lawful purpose for which money in any of the Town's other funds may be used;

WHEREAS, it is estimated that in the year 2023 the Town will receive \$12,799.58 per month, totaling \$153,595.00 for the year;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 6-3.6-6-9.5(e) provides that the capital improvement plan must encompass a period of not less than two (2) years and must include projects the cost of which is at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the fractional amount of additional revenue allocated for economic development purposes that is expected to be received by the town in the period covered by the capital improvement plan; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 6-3.6-6-9.5(c) provides that the capital improvement plan must be adopted before a county, city, or town may receive its certified distribution of CEDIT revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Town Council hereby adopts the Capital Improvement Plan of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
