# A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING IOCRA GRANT APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the "Town") recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, THAT:

- 1. The Town Council President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address wastewater improvements, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Whiteland, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), in the form of \$15,000 from the Town's CEDIT Fund as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of Planning funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.

DULY PASSED AND FINALLY ADOPTED on the 17 day of September. 2023, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against.
