ORDINANCE 2023-15

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS IN THE 2023 TOWN BUDGET

WHEREAS: it has been shown and determined that certain existing appropriations within the 2023 Town Budget now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It has been shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated. Therefore, the following existing appropriations shall be reduced in the following amounts:

FUND NAME: Parks & Recreation:

FUND NAME: Cum Cap Imp:

Capital Outlays	\$40,000.00

FUND NAME: Local Road & Street:

Capital Outlays	\$20,000.00

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Town Council. The provisions of this Ordinance shall supersede the provisions of any previous Ordinance in conflict herewith.

PASSED through first reading by the Town Council on the 14 day of November 2023, by a vote of 4 in favor and 0 against.


