Best Way looks forward to providing the **TOWN OF WHITELAND** with courteous and dependable curbside collection.

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

FREQUENCY

Trash will be picked up one time per week. Trash must be curbside no later than 7:00 a.m. and contained within the Best Way tote.

Recyclables will be picked up every other week on the same day as the regular trash day. ALL RECYCLABLES MUST FIT IN THE DESIGNATED CART.

In the event of a holiday week, if the holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, trash service will be delayed one day. If the holiday falls on a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, trash service will not be interrupted.

LIMIT

There is a 95-gallon limit per week. All waste must be contained inside the provided tote. Extra bag stickers can be purchased at the Whiteland Town Hall. Please place the extra bag sticker on the bag where the driver can see it, then set out with your regular trash.

HEAVY TRASH

Heavy trash pick up will be the first regularly scheduled trash day of every month. All heavy trash must fit into one truck hopper.

Heavy trash **CAN** include:

- Furniture
- Broken glass/mirrors (must be wrapped in cardboard and taped)
- Mattresses (preferably wrapped in plastic)
- Carpeting and other flooring scraps (bundled max 4'x4' pieces)
- Other large bulk items
- Non-freon appliances (freon appliances must be certification from a licensed tech verifying that all freon has been removed before placing curbside).

Heavy trash CANNOT include:

- NO dirt, sod, rocks, pavers, concrete, cement blocks
- NO tires or auto parts
- NO electronics of any type
- NO batteries, used oil, paint and shingles, pesticides, automotive fluids, or any other household chemicals
- NO large metal pieces
- NO construction debris

RECYCLING

WHAT SHOULD BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

- Aluminum/Bi-Metal beverage cans, clean aluminum foil/trays
- Steel food cans Rinsed
- Plastics #1 and #2 ONLY Rinsed
 This includes soda pop and water
 bottles, milk jugs, and laundry products
- Glass brown, blue, green, or clear food or beverage containers
- Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, or junk mail
- Paperboard (cereal/cracker boxes)
- Brown paper bags
- Clean parts of pizza boxes

WHAT SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

- NO plastics #3-#7
- NO trash
- NO wax coated paper or food wrappers
- NO plastic bags of any kind
- NO window panes, glassware, ceramics, light bulbs
- NO styrofoam packing materials or food containers
- NO electronics of any type
- NO grass, leaves or other yard waste
- NO dirty/greasy pizza boxes



If the holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, trash service will be delayed one day. If the holiday falls on a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, trash service will be on a regular schedule.
