WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR USE OF THE WATERWORKS OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the "Town Council") has established rates and charges for the waterworks system of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the "Town"); and

WHEREAS, the Town has employed Reedy Financial Group P.C. (the "Financial Advisor") to prepare a study regarding water rates and charges of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Advisor has prepared and submitted a rate study (the "Rate Report"), which evaluated the Town's water rates and charges; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1.5-3-8.1, this Council may change or adjust its existing schedule of fees by ordinance after introducing the ordinance establishing the new rates and providing notice and conducting a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 8-1.5-3-8 authorizes the Town Council to adopt by ordinance a nondiscriminatory, reasonable and just schedule of rates and charges for water services rendered by the Town's waterworks system; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ind. Code § 8-1.5-3-8.1, notice has been given of the public hearing on the proposed rates contained herein; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Town Council, at which time testimony from interested persons was received, after introduction of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined it is necessary to amend the rates and charges for water services rendered by the Town's waterworks system as found in the Town's Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Council finds that the rates and charges adopted by this Ordinance are reasonable and just in order to provide for the proper level of revenue requirements for operation and maintenance expenses; debt service; the costs of capital replacements; and to maintain the waterworks system in the sound physical and financial condition necessary to render adequate and efficient service.

SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2025 and to be first implemented with the bills issued in February 2025 and due in March 2025, or as soon thereafter as the revised rates and charges can be implemented by the Town's billing system, the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), Section 51.35(A), shall be amended to read as follows:

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§ 51.35 RATES AND CHARGES.

(A) Rates and charges. There is hereby established, for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks system of the town, the following rates and charges based upon the use of water supplied by the waterworks system:

SECTION 3. Effective January 1, 2025 and to be first implemented with the bills issued in February 2025 and due in March 2025, or as soon thereafter as the revised rates and charges can be implemented by the Town's billing system, the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), Section 51.35(C), shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 51.35 RATES AND CHARGES.

(C) Bulk water service stations. Water purchased through a bulk water service station shall be charged at the following rate:

SECTION 4. Effective January 1, 2025 and to be first implemented with the bills issued in February 2025 and due in March 2025, or as soon thereafter as the revised rates and charges can be implemented by the Town's billing system, the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), Section 51.36, shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 51.36 FIRE HYDRANT AND FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE CHARGES.

(A) Fire hydrant charges.

SECTION 5. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), Section 51.42, shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 51.42 TAP-ON FEE.

Each user connecting to the waterworks system shall pay a Tap-on Fee. At the time an application for connection to the waterworks system is filed, or a request for change in water service connection, the applicable water Tap-on Fee shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>SECTION 6</u>. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code), Section 51.46, shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 51.46 CAPACITY CHARGE.

Each property owner requesting water service shall pay a capacity charge. At the time an application for a building permit is filed, or other request for water service, the applicable water capacity charge shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule:

SECTION 7. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, a new Section 51.48 of the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code) shall be established to read as follows:

§ 51.48 WATER FLOW TEST FEES.

Persons conducting or obtaining a water flow test must schedule the flow test in advance through the water department and shall pay a \$200 fee plus pay for the water used in the flow test in an amount equal to the number of gallons used multiplied by the volume rate for bulk water. If a flow test is not scheduled in advance or is performed without the presence of an authorized town representative, the flow test fee shall be \$400 plus the water volume charge. If a flow test does not use a meter, the volume of water used will be estimated by the Director of Operations, but will be estimated at no less than 20,000 gallons.

SECTION 8. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, a new Section 51.49 of the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code) shall be established to read as follows:

§ 51.49 PAYMENTS IN LIEU OF PROPERTY TAXES.

The Town Council hereby authorizes the town to receive payments in lieu of property taxes from its utilities to the extent permitted by applicable law.

SECTION 9. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, a new Section 51.50 of the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code) shall be established to read as follows:

§ 51.50 RETURN ON UTILITY PLANT.

The Town Council hereby authorizes the town to earn a reasonable return on the utility plant of its utilities to the extent permitted by applicable law.

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SECTION 10. Effective upon the final approval of this Ordinance, Section 51.24 of the Whiteland Code of Ordinances (a.k.a. Whiteland Municipal Code) shall be revised to read as follows:

§ 51.24 INSTALLATION OF NEW WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS.

The town will provide and install the new water meter determined appropriate for new residential, commercial, and/or industrial connections to the town's waterworks, but otherwise the new customer of the property to be newly connected shall be responsible for all other materials and labor necessary to connect the property to the town's waterworks systemfor installation of the meters determined appropriate for each residential, commercial and/or industrial customer on service at the time of the passage of this section. However, upon request, the town will allow if any residential, commercial and/or industrial customer desires to hire or provide the labor and material, except the meter, for the installation of the approved meter for a new connection, and the town waterworks will provide the meter.

SECTION 11. The Council hereby authorizes and directs the appropriate officials and representatives of the Town to take all necessary actions to implement this Ordinance following final adoption.

SECTION 12. All prior ordinance provisions in conflict herewith are repealed.

<u>SECTION 13</u>. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and its invalidity shall have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 14. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final adoption.
